



### BUTTHOLE SURFERS



BUTTHOLE SURFING, is that somthin the tidy bowl man does on weekends? No you jerk! Butthole Surfers is the name of a real (i think) band which I had the pleasure of seeing live on Christmas day 1983 at the GRAVEN IMAGE in downtown Seattle (somewhere around the corner of 3rd and Western).

The Butthole Surfers are a five piece band consisting of 2 (count em 2!) drummers, King and Teresa Coffee and three other members Gibby, Paul and Willy who switch off on guitar, bass, sax and vocals The bands Sound is actually great and to see them live they put on an excellent show! High energy and

unpredictable.

The BUTTHOLE SURFERS are home based in Texas but had been touring in Seattle and got stranded due to lack of funds this gig was to raise money to help get the band home. Slamming, skanking and just hopping around was the only way to stay warm and there wasn't any lack of that.

After the show we got together and the band answered a few question ns and here's what it was like:

SO WHAT ARE YOU GUYS DOING IN SEATTLE?

paul: "We're learning to wipe, naturly. gibby:....yes we're learning to clean ourselves, you know there's a lota states where you really can't learn to clean your self.like Texas is not a real clean state, California...." paul:"...a man can reach down in Seattle and not be afraid of ... you know what he comes up with."

WHERE ARE YOU FROM ORIGINALLY? gibby: "We're from San Antonio, Austin,

Dallas and Fortworth.

HOW DID YOU GET A NAME LIKE BUTTHOLE SURFERS?

gibby: "We've never been asked that question before". (ha! ha!ha!) paul:....We started out being called NINE FOOT WORM MAKES OWN FOOD and then changed the name to ASHTRAY BABY HEADS and from there we became the VODKA FAMILY WINSTONS and we had a song called BUTTHOLE SURFERS and then everybody started calling us that and that's what stuck",

gibby: "We were introduced as the BUTTHOLE SURFERS in Austin and so everyone said, yeah Butthole Surfers. yeah that's pretty cool.





paul: "yeah there a real goood band, heard of em. (pauses to sign auto-I heard of em. (pauses to sign auto-graph-really).....Hacky Sack sucks! gibby: "...and so does E.T. paul: "E.T. was a puppet"!

O'KAY NOW, WHAT'S THE BUTTHOLE SURFERS MUSIC ALL ABOUT?

gibby: "Oh, it's about ...

paul:"...girlfriends who stick their i INSTERMUNT FOR THE WHOLE NIGHT.EVERY- sack in a kungfu world". tongues up your...whatever,never mind BODY PLAYS GUITAR, EVERYBODY PLAYS SAX I won't say that". (lots of laughter) EVERYBODY PLAYS BASS, ARMPIT WHATEVER. gibby: "That's pretty observent of trying to a....nail the forces of physic space travel and bow movement, think that's what it boils down to. paul: "We are not a cocaine front

our brother is a lawyer, we been on the Q.E.2., we been on physic space travel and we are not...
gibby: "We talked to Willie Nelson,

webumped into Rex Harrison, we talked long distance on the phone ....

willy: "We're friends with Jello Biafra (jello produced this bands most recent and only album to date). gibby: "Yeah and there's onthing I want to get straight, Jello Biafra IS NOT A ROCKSTAR!!!!!

paul: "He's fuckin allergic to dogs, he hates dogs! So we have nothing nice to say about him".

HOLD ON HOW DID WE GET ON THE SUBJECT OF JELLO ANYWAY?

PAUL: "Cauuse he's our best buddy, he gives us a place to sleep when we're homeless".

TELL ME A LITTLE ABOUT EACH MEMBER OF THE BAND.

GIBBY: "O'kay we got King and Teresa Coffee, who areAbrother and sister duo who have been playing in marching bands throughout the Southwest. They were like the only white drummers in the Grambling Band and ah

WHAT'S YOUR NAME AND WHAT DO YOU PLAY willy: "Willy ... I play bass"

paul: "He's just a nigger, we're not racial. Shut-up nigger! DOES WILLY PLAY GOOD?

paul: "He's a nigger, of corse he plays good, goddamn man, fuckin all niggers play the bass good, shit". SO HAVE YOU ENJOYED YOUR VISIT TO SEATTLE?

gibby: "Oh it's been marvlous, wonderful, fantastic, amazing, etc. Got any other groovy questions? come on

HOW WOULD YOU LIKE TO COME TO ALASKA gibby: "I'd love to come to Alaska. What's my favorite color?...Brown. I DIDN'T ASK YOU THAT , YOU ASKED YOUR SELF THAT, COME ON 1'M DOING THE INTERVIEW.

gibby: "This here's Teresa Coffee (introducing Teresa to me).

teresa: "Hello"

DO YDU LIKE DOING WHAT YOUR DOING? teresa: "Well I could Take it or leave it".

THEN WHAT ARE YOU DOING WITH THIS BUNCH OF BUTTHOLE SURFERS?

teresa: "I'm sorta stuck with my brother, I went through years of watching TV and then I decided to hit the road with my brother and his friends who fart in the van and make awful smells, but ut's not bad" WHAT HAVE YOU GOT TO SAY ABOUT THE BUTTHOLE SURFERS THAT EVERY BODY SHOULD KNOW?

gibby: "Tell em something good". teresa: "They all have B.O. in the summer time and Gibby waves his weenie at everyone when we're in

close quaters.

willy: "Ask these guys about wrestling. They're wrestling fanatics. gibby: "I don't know about the . Alaska wrestling scene. paul: "WE're surprised that wrestling and punk rock is not more combined in the great Northwest.I mean in Texas you can not differinciate between wrestling and punk rock. I mean it all comes together, the music, the wrestling it happens at the same place and at the same time.

O'KAY ONE FINAL QUESTION.... gibby: "We'll pre-answer it...cheese" paul: "Dogs love the taste of cheese" JUST WONDERED IF YOU HAVE ANYTHING IMPORTANT TO SAY TO THE PUNK COMMU NITY OF ALASKA?

paul: "Hacky sack sucks! Fuck hacky

gibby: "Never let hacky sack take control of your life, never".

paul:"....if you see someone playing hacky sack, you go up to him and tell em hacky sack sucks! And you embarrass him in front of his date, cause there is no place for hacky

Can you give us alittle background
on yourselves?

JOHN: I come from alot of places.

I've lived in West Covina, Denver,
Vancouver, Washington(Portland
area, yeah!!) Honolulu(Double yeah!)

& Mt Vernon, Washington. I've been
in about 6 bands before the Accused.
I'm 19 years old.

TOM: I lived most of my 18 year life in Oxnard/Ventura, Ca. I've been in about three bands before moving up to Washington State in March of '80 to join Chewy & Dana & form the trio "Gang Green". Chewy sang & there was no bass... rough sound to say the

How did you arrive at the band's name?


TOM: Dana came up with the name The Accused. For obvious reasons it fits us young ones.

What inspired you to put this band together?

JOHN:Chewy, Dana & Tom formed "Gang Green" out of boredom. They sounded like they've always had some sort of message to get across lyrically-even from the beginning. Lately, it's gotten more accurate and consequently more professional.

Which of you does the majority of the writing?

JOHN: We've all written lyrics, but I can't write good music, so I concentrate on lyrics and leave music to the others.



TOM: "No Reason", "Bring the Riots".

are fuckin' great songs & they were
written by Dana!!! (ha!ha! just kidding!!) No, we all have written our
share of words.

How important are lyrical statements to the band members?

JOHN: Our lyrics lately try to put

an emphasis on "punker than thou" attudes in the scene.

TOM: We feel strongly about every word we sing. Plain & simple. Any band that doesn't is fucked & doesn't belong on Earth. Interpret them how

you want. Beware though! Our brains are ours- yours are your's.

Having a important emphasis on your lyrics, how do you feel that punk attitudes are formed, or spread throughout the subculture?

TOM: Hopefully, people will begin to listen, truly interpret meaning from songs by their fave band. Too many punks have a quincy-punk attitude all over the U.S. They are simply misunderstanding what punk has to offer their normally dull life. Giv'em time.

Can you sketch out a brief profile of the movement as you see it?


TOM: I don't think it's dying- not energy-wise. I think kids, adults, etc. are realizing that punk is some thing that offers so much more than music & dress. It's a movement that hopefully will be directly associated (one day) with "intelligent thinking. There are lots of bands cropping up these days. Let's hope they keep up a decent attitude & don't just assume punks are suppose to hurt, kill fuck, maim & get wasted. We're not opposed to sex, drugs or alcohol by any means(hiccup) but the quincy mentality, once again is the wrong idea.

You put out a 22-song demo tape in Dec. 182, (which I thought was great!) recently you did a 27-song L.P. with "The Rejectors" Are you satified with the end result?

JOHN: I don't hate it. I don't think it's very representative of what we sound like now.

Which direction to you plan to go with your music?

JOHN: Disco!!! TOM: Yeah, it's so "out" it's "in". Kinda like punk! JOHN: No, Country /Western. Hoe-down. We like to Hoe-down lots! \*\* You've come along way from jamming in the basement of Tom's house in Oak Harbor. Do you keep in touch with your fans? Surely you have some, right?
