

Ska is, like punk, an attitude Fedora a mod does not make. Although Ska's surge of popularity peaked in 1980-81 in Europe (of course) and has since faded into virtual obscurity, the memories of those speed-fed days of old spent in London pubs dancing to those who put Ska on the charts live vibrantly on in the form of a British film, "Dance Craze."

A documentary beginning complete with soothing voice; what the kids these days do for entertainment-Dance! Flashed across the screen in various forms, the word makes an appropriate opening for such a movie as this. The Specials! The Beat! Madness! Selecter! Bad Manners! The Body Snatchers! Each name appears in ominous yellow letters, drawing enthusiastic audience responce- a holler for their favorite band.

Terry Hall, the Specials striking lead singer, fills the screen as the psychedelic ska sounds of "Concrete Jungle" blare. Blood pumps; feet tap, It is easy to see this is going to be an energenic evening. Tentatively three of four people jungle in the area cleared of seats by the thoughtful and knowing theatre owners. Very soon they are joined by the ma-jority of the theatre crowd.

Madness's Chas Smash, nutty glasses perched precariously on the tip of his nose while jerkily parades in front of the crowd which fills the tiny pub, bellows, "Hey you! Don't watch that! Watch this! This is the heav, heavy monster sound! ONE STEP BEYOND!!" So continues the saga...

The movie is filled with the best of those who do it, and the best of what they do-- a bounding "Mirror in the Bathroom" from the Beat; Selin the Bathroom" from the Beat; Selecter's choppy "Three Minute Hero"; a lilting, toe tapping "Easy Life" by the Body Snatchers; "Lip Up Fatty" appropriately performed by Bad Manners' gorilla of a lead singer-- on and on.

Spliced into "Dance Craze" is a real documentary; black and white from the early '50's. No Stray Cats here,







This is probably the best thing they've ever flone. Also included, is the Descendants most unusual "I want to be a bear", Anti (generic), III Will (dumb). Divil Dismay - 3 songs by them, tho "Filch" really stants out, great song China White (fast metal punk, like their EP). FORMER SUBHUMAN AND FRIENDS ON TRIAL

FOR THEIR LIVES AND OUR FRE



n Jan. 20th, 1983, five BC activists were seized on a lonely highway 30 miles north of Vancouver by an RCMP tactical squad. They were promptly charged with a host of alleged "TERRORIST" activities including: bombing Litton Industries of Toronto (which produces the guidence system for the deadly cruise missile); bombing a BC Hydro substation, and firebombing three video pornography stores.

The arrests were immediately followed by a media blitz of hysteria and sensationalism, making it impossiable to have a fair trial (not that a fair trial was what the crown had in mind). The five accused were denied bail and a preliminary hearing and their friends and supporters were (and continue to be) harrassed by police at hearings and at home.





The five have all been politically active for years in various social concerns such as anti-nuclear activities, the women's movement, anti-pornography struggles, native rights, pacifist projects, efforts to improve conditions of work, welfare rights, prisoner support work, environmental issues - in short, with issues that are fundamental to furthering the dignity of humankind and the survival of this planet.

One of the five, Gerry Hannah, aka Gerry Useless, was instrumental in the founding of the Vancouver punk scene and was one of the original members of Vancouvers SUBHUMANS. He was also involved in organizing and




