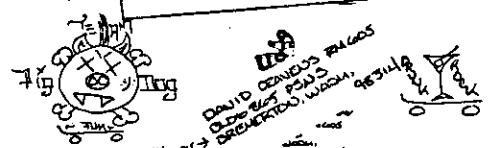

on the local scene in Anchorage things are definatly picking-up.

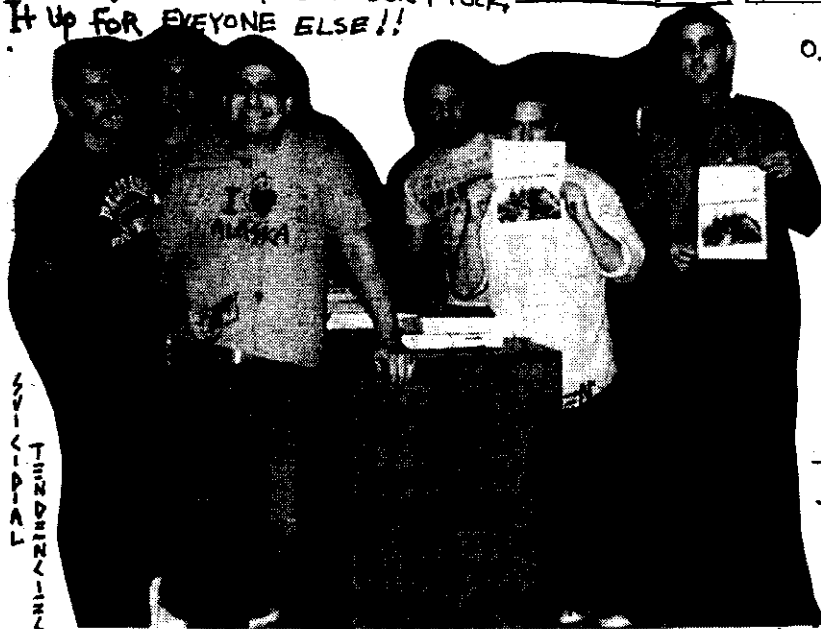
I hear about "SKATE DEATH" playing more gigs and parties. "URBAN TRIBE" and "ANGY NUNS" are rolling again.

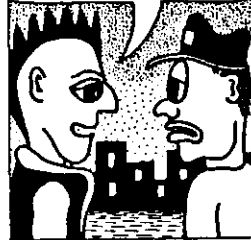
One of the better parties recently was MIT'S Party were S.D. and Last Wipe played. a lot of people showed up for a private party but everything ended real

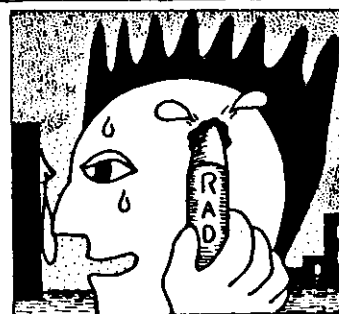

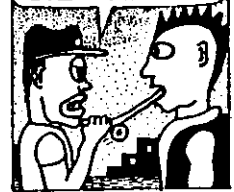

Hello!

I managed to get hold of a copy of Warning (N°4) and because I enjoyed reading it I thought I'd write. I suppose you'll be on N°5 at least by now. There were a few things that I disagreed with (after thinking about it) but overall I enjoyed it, keep up the good work. Yes I did read it all!!

I don't agree that the 'punk sheep' need leaders, they need to think for themselves. No leaders, no heroes... think for yourself - follow no one. I really enjoyed the "Bill Board Back in School?" bit, that was excellent.

Anyway what have I written for? Well a few things... I'd like to know how to get hold of any more issues of Warning... maybe I could swap you British zines for it? I'm doing one at the moment... I'll send you a copy when it's finished.

The 'punk' scene in the U.K. is very stagnant at the moment. In standard 'punk' sounds there are very few new bands. Old bands like GBH etc have been sued, most punks think for themselves and rip-off bands aren't tolerated. Conflict is the biggest band and animal rights is the biggest influence on 'punk' songs these days.

Good U.K. Punk groups like Corpse, Sear, Rebel, Thrust, Anti-System are becoming more popular with the intelligent punks.

U.K. opinion is being moulded to a pro-U.S.A. stance in time for Reagan's visit on June 9th, make no mistake, his is not welcome. The placement of Cruise missiles endangers the whole of the world population but particularly the U.K. which will become a radioactive wasteland if Reagan decides to press the button.

There are 135 U.S. bases on British soil, we don't want them, we welcome you Americans, we like you but not your bombs! We don't want to die in Reagan's war.

The 'city' of London has been the site of two demonstrations in the past 6 months and is the site of 2 more soon. The first on May 31st the next on September 27th (Feel free to bring your ideas and imagination to St. Paul's cathedral at 8:00am that morning) All are welcome.

The 'city' is the HQ of all the banks etc and the financial heart of the U.K. The money which they make is made from the misery, pain and death of millions of animals and people. Police brutality is widespread, on the last demo 450 were arrested, many more got a kicking off the police, we will not be beaten. We can 'stop the city' we will 'stop the city'. If you oppose the system, and are going to be in U.K. around September 27th then be there!

"The Mod Sound", Perhaps it does not exist. The original mods, "Modernists", in Italy (1958) loved modern jazz & clothes, hence: "Mods". As for the modern jazz sound, cats like Ornette Coleman, John Coltrane, Charlie (Bird) Parker, Red Norvo & Winton Marsalis are some of the Mod-jazz players of now & the past.

There's also the Mod sound of 1967's punk like: The High Numbers, The Small Faces, The Creation, The Zombies, The Move, and, of course, The Action. Most of these bands, however, took some (if not all) of their inspiration from 60's soul like: James Brown, Wilson Pickett, Otis Redding, Sam & Dave, Curtis Mayfield. Also Motown artists like: The Marvalettes, Diana Ross, Smokey, Stevie Wonder, and numerous others. Even if some of these artists did not directly inspire, it was still part of "That Sound".

Most of those bands got more psychedelic sounding as time went on, though. Can you dig it? All of these branches are part of the "Mod Tree", of sound, or whatever.

Bands that would appeal to kiddos in to H.C. or Punk are the Mod revival bands of the late 70's like: The Chords, Secret Affair, The Teenbeats, Squire, The Jolt, plus many, many more. There's also the ska & ska revival, which happened at about the same time. 2-tone, Blue Beat like: The Specials, The Selecter, Madness, The Beat & Bad Manners, all own this up-beat, light ska sound.

SO, Just what is this "Mod" thing, though? Good question. I'll take the reporters stance on this issue. As I already told where it started I'll move on to say that it caught on a bit and expanded. The biggest mod scene was, of course, in England in the early to mid 60's. One thing most, who regard themselves as "Mods" won't tell you, is that it is any sort of a trend or fad. Well, sorry to disappoint you guys, but look at some who were "Mods" in the 60's. Needless to say there were alot who did it "Just to fit in". Of course there were those few, who were truly in-to-it and dedicated. The "other" were usually kids who had nothing else to spend their money on.

With that all the "real" & original Mods cut themselves away from the mass-scene. Enter "Individualists" & "Stylists". A "Ticket" or "Number" was an every-day sort of a Mod, not as authentic, or as smartly dressed as a "Face", that made the "Faces" top-Mods-so on.

Rocket: It's not true at all. We're doing this benefit for the homeless right? Well we're fighting for squatter's rights. People should realize there's alot of empty buildings all around us. If the city would let us squat like they do in England then lots of people wouldn't be homeless. We could have unity with the city ya know. The facility is there, just let us have it. We've been squatting for the last month or so. The cops come and raid the place, they don't bust anybody or put us in jail they just kick us out. Why can't they just let us stay there and take care of this old house? I mean we painted it and fixed all up, the electricity was turned on. We had a community that was so lovable man, it's so much fun to live with people, like ten or twenty people under one roof. Go from one room to another with something always going on. Just a beautiful family going.

Do you feel there's enough support in the scene here?

Rocket: Punks come on down man. We need your support. Yeah, people are aware here they just don't know how to connect with each other very well. Everyone knows it's fucked around but they don't know the answers or what to do about changing it.

"HOMELESS BENEFIT"
THE MAB-MAY 9, '84

This show consisted of five bands which donated their time & talents to raise money for the street people. One band really stood out from the others. So I hung around to get an interview with Unity Instigation.

Rocket: I'm with Rider. Unity Instigation. UI. U and I.

Rider: It takes two to make three. When people are happening in a direction they tend to get there. If you sit on your ass, well you find out that apathy kills as you grow older and fatter.

So when did you guys get started?

Rider: We got started years ago. We're happening now and a this future looks pretty bleak. So that's why we're trying to change it. We're here to change the world, we feel it's coming down in a big, fast boom. That's what shell shock is about right now, that's what we're about. Cause we're trying to do what we can where we're at. Our songs have a message of freedom, of individual freedom that's not conformity we're not trying to start a religion or a government. We're trying to be free, be what America's about. If you do that inside yourself then you're free.

Rocket: That's what unity is about. Unity can change things ya know. The government has weapons & money and all that crazy shit ya know. They think that it'll help change things or help keep things peaceful. But we believe that by getting people together we're more powerful than any bomb they could make. We could stop alot of shit that's going on by uniting. And S.F. is happening. Come down here there's free gigs, free shows, free food and a community that believes in changing things.

Rider: That's unity, take a stand where you are.

Rocket: Ok the band's been together about 6 months, we've been through about three drummers. The names are Rider on vocals, Rocket on bass, Mike Pete on guitar and Paul on drums. We're from S.F.

How often do you guys practice, your show tonight was very tight.

Rocket: Not often, cuz there's no place to practice. That's one thing we don't have in this city is a facility for punks to get together and practice. We did this show without a practice just because we had this benefit to play for so we just came together for it. So send your money!!

What's happening in the Colorado Underground? Well, besides a lot of fascinating geological formations and wet spring snowstorms, there's a growing interest in the performance and appreciation of independent music. AEON Tapes of Fort Collins has been distributing local music on cassette for the last several years on an international scale. In the past, they have carried cassettes of The Mnemonists, a renowned Fort Collins experimental band, and are currently carrying an item by Boulder avant group ARCHITECTS. OFFICE. AEON is very particular about the items they distribute, so you can be assured of high quality underground product. Their sources are international and their catalog reflects that. Meanwhile, a lot of the tapes and records available through AEON find their way onto KGNU's "Under The Floorboards" program, late Saturday nights in Boulder. Underground music has been slyly introduced to afternoon programming as well. KGNU, Public Radio Boulder, has several live experimental programs planned for the near future in conjunction with Boulder groups WALLS OF GENIUS and ARCHITECTS OFFICE. If you have tapes of new music, send them to KGNU in care of Paul Mettors, Music Director. You will almost be guaranteed airplay by several deejays focusing on independent new music.

ARCHITECTS OFFICE, in Boulder, offers the listener organized noise, sound, and aleatoric composition. Recordings of angry people, television drama, and classical music mix live with synthesizers, vocalisations, toys, and percussive devices. They have several cassettes available and can be contacted directly or through WALLS OF GENIUS. ARCHITECTS OFFICE has had several live performances this spring to enthusiastic audiences and may even be available soon on vinyl.

CRUEL POSTURE, in Colorado Springs, has a cassette available ("Accidence"), which presents hard driving rock as well as industrial composition with tapes, synthesizers, and the mysterious "Fx". Songs like "Fits In A Drum" create an eerie dreamlike sensation that is not altogether unpleasant. According to the group, a second cassette will be available shortly, reflecting a more sophisticated attitude towards composition and experiment. In their own words, "There is nothing else happening in Colorado Springs"... From my own visits to Colorado Springs, I can well believe it! CRUEL POSTURE can be contacted through Man-Ray tapes.

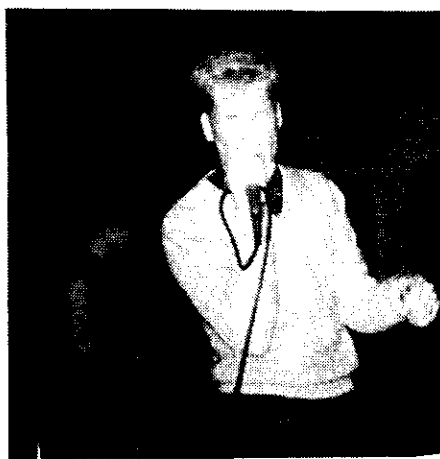
WALLS OF GENIUS, "home tapers with a vengeance", have fourteen cassettes available, all reflecting the eclectic taste of its makers. Ranging from off-the-cuff desecrations of American Pop Music to serious electronic and industrial avant-garde composition, they continue to stay one step ahead of even their most devoted listeners, never failing to surprise or delight. W o G will be sponsoring several live performances in Boulder in the upcoming months. These include "The Furballs From Outer Space", a full-fledged extravaganza complete with local stand-up comedians and "Avant-garde Musik", live minimal improvisation with bass guitar, bass clarinet, and synthesizer. Recently a W o G incarnation, "The Fabulous Pus-Tones" performed pop music destruction at The Festival of Pain in Denver alongside several noise music ensembles. Meanwhile, "Joe Colorado" continues to perform his demented versions of pop classics at the Monday night coffeehouse at Pachamama's in Boulder, bringing a new music perspective to a traditionally conservative audience. His versions are featured on several WALLS OF GENIUS cassettes. As far as The Festival of Pain is concerned, I hope to bring you more information soon about experimental Denver musicians Neal Feather, John Sheehan and Ken DeVries' "Revelation 13", all of whom appeared at The Festival.

MATTHEW SOMMERVILLE, in Denver also, is a very articulate exponent of the organization of environmental sounds and has produced a tasteful cassette of noise and sound synthesis. He combines radio broadcasts and downtown construction of Denver skyscrapers with tradition electronic synthesis. The listener can literally feel the rhythm of a "spectacular sight" rising from the ground in a city fueled by petroleum profit. Somerville has been featured on the Belgian cassette compilation "3R-10" (Juliaan Dillensstraat 22B, 2018 Antwerpen, Belgium). He can also be contacted directly.

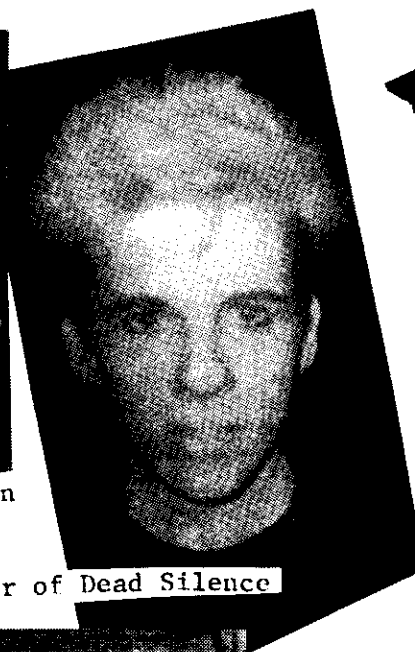

DENVER SCENE REPORT April 4, 1984

Sad news from the Front Range as comes the announcement that Kennedy's Warehouse will be closing it's doors in April or May. Kennedy's is the only venue in Colorado that caters exclusively to hardcore. Headbanger, in charge of booking, says he will continue to find out-of-the-way places to hold his shows. Kennedy's hosted such out of town shows as T.S.O.L., Hüsker Dü, Discharge, No Trend, Massacre Guys, Jerry's Kidz, and No Direction.

Aside from Bookings in Denver call HEADBANGER (303) 295-9103
As far as local goes - Bum Kon, denver thrash favorites, have a new EP out called "Drunken Sex Sucks" on Local Anesthetic Records. One of Denver's best releases yet, so check it out. The Lepers from Boulder, have officially broken up but will continue to work together on new releases on their Unclean Records label. They have a "7" EP of None of the Above from Tulsa, OK, coming out, as well as a 7" EP by Rhythm Pigs from El Paso, TX.

Unclean has also just finished a compilation album called "I Thought I Told You to Shut Up!" which includes Articles of Faith, N.O.T.A., Lepers, Massacre Guys, Bum Kon, Micronotz, Clitboys, Final Conflict and Psycho. It should be out soon.

Peace Core, another Denver favorite, has played out quite a bit lately and really become a driving force in the Denco scene. They should have a cassette available soon. Happy World are a great 3-piece that play thrash and older style punk with humorous lyrics. Lots of energy. Malibu Kens are another power trio with loads of energy and a little more emphasis on discipline. Hopefully, the 2 former bands will have some product available soon. The Butcherz, headed by Headbanger thrash also but flirt with heavy metal at times. Their best song is "Whoopee Shit."

Other bands in Denver that are playing out are Legion of Doom, Chelsea Girls, Anti-Scrunti Faction (A.S.F.), Shamed Hatred, Immoral Attitude, Acid Ranch, & Spontaneous Down Syndrome from Cheyenne, WYO.

Two good fanzines in Denver are Something Better Change and Lick It Up. In Boulder, a real good political fanzine called Dead Silence is published by Vulture.

Greetings from Olympia! May 5, 1984

Picked up a copy of "Warning" #10 in Seattle yesterday, and I was very impressed. I had read "Warning" before, but this latest issue surpasses all others that I had exposure to. Especially liked the Suicidal Tendencies essays and the graphics were great! Keep up the good work...

I don't know if you get much mail from Olympia (other than from Nan Warshaw) so I'll fill you in on what the music scene is like down here. Well, we finally got a club. About two months ago the Fabulus (not a typo) Tropicana opened its doors downtown as a haven for Olympia's ostracized and unusual. There's no age limit, admission is cheap (\$3.00 or close to it), and most importantly, the atmosphere is great: people are real friendly, you can dance any way you want to (this can be a problem in Olympia), and people respect the premises. Some bands that have played there (regional or national) include Personality Crisis, Circle Seven, the Three O'Clock, House of Commons, and later this month, Life In General will be driving down from Seattle. We have a good selection of local punk bands (better make that rock bands because not all of them play hardcore, but none of them play Journey-esque schlock) such as Beat Happening (currently in Japan), Immortal Roberts, M.E.L.V.I.N.S. (they're from Aberdeen, actually), and the increasingly droll Young Pioneers. It's surprising (well, to me at least) that Olympia, a conservative, government, retirement-home town has such a spunky scene and brings in so many bands. It's great! New people are continually showing up at the Tropicana and checking it out, which is great! It's good to see the youth (primarily) of Olympia get out of their homes and into the streets. The entire town should benefit by an increase in social dissent.

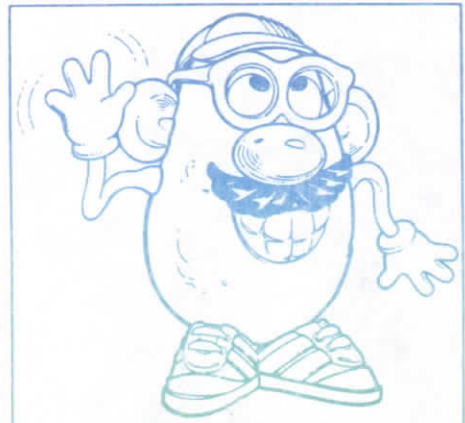

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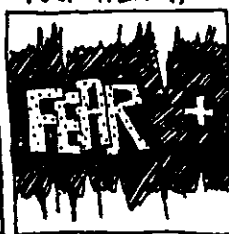
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NEW YORK - It's one of the last CBGB matinees, home for two years to weekly Saturday afternoon hardcore shows. The band is Major Conflict, from Queens by way of Avenue A, a red-hot bunch of thrashers who got their start in the original line-up of the great, late Urban Waste.

Major Conflict's kick starts with Johnny Waste, whose stinging, slashing, original startingly guitar leads propel the band's frantic fast-paced thrash anthems. MajCon is a real New York band, a genuine melting pot: John Dancy, the superfast drummer, is black, bassist Nick hails from France, second guitarist Dito is Oriental.

At their center, lead singer Billy Phillips provides the focus, bringing it all together. Today he's in jock chic: black sweatpants, matching wrist bands, a black&white baseball jersey and a denim jacket cut down to a vest.

The band rumbles through "How Do Ya Feel," their instrumental opener; Billy doing a quick-step new-wavey dance all over the stage. "Central Park Slaying" blasts through the speakers - a real hardcore pop song, with a melody you'll hum all the way home. It's early spring; t-shirts and skateboards dot the crowd. It's time to crank it up.

Billy fades to the back of the stage during one of Johnny's manic solos, and in one quick move whips his jersey and vest over his head. Bare-chested, he leaps to ~~center~~ center stage, arms raised. The crowd freaks into slamming, spinning, skanking chaos. "Dirty Sneakers" is next, with its unity ~~chorus~~ chorus, everybody chanting "We're gonna riot tonight!" By the end of the set, the pit at CBGB is sweat-soaked and wrung out to dry. Great show.

"Having a band is all around great & fun when we're playing in front of people we know who support local bands and show unity among each other," says Billy. The band's 45, "Outgroup"/"Not Just A Song," just went into its second printing of 1000 copies and is selling well (it's \$3 from Major Conflict, 24-07 31st Street, Astoria, NY 11102). And the band starts recording for a 12" lp soon.

Unlike a lot of hardcore bands, when you ask MajCon what they like, they list a lot of influences from outside hardcore: Billy's into Motorhead, Metallica, Zero Boys, and Black Sabbath; Johnny Waste's favorites include Ramones, Iron Maiden, and lots of guitar heroes; John Dancy likes Motley Crue and Accept. Yet these guys don't have a heavy-metal sound; lots of thunder 'n lightning guitar, sure, but Minor Threat were lots more metal.

For all the great licks and beats that Johnny, Dito, and John provide, it's Billy the crowd comes to see. He says, "When I perform I'm locked inside myself, I don't see or hear anything else but the band. I enjoy performing in front of people and wouldn't give it up for anything." Sometimes, because of the way he rolls around the stage, dives into the crowd, and strips his shirt off, Billy is compared to Iggy Pop, but he doesn't think that's the case. "I guess taking my shirt off comes naturally 'cause I take it off at home and on I stage I feel at home. I've been doing things this way since Urban Waste when I was 16, now I'm 19."

Wait till he turns 20. Henry Rollins, watch out.

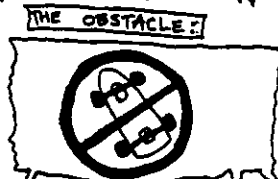
