




Dear Warning

Testerday I picked up your latest issue at Robber Joes. I've been reading Warning since the first issue, although I've missed a few issues as I only spend my summers here in anon and go to school Outside. I'm not really muon into punk music, although I like the Hamones and the first CLASH album is probably one of the best albums of all time. I also like ABBA, so sorry to all you pigeonhole punkers who limit themselves to what someone else tells them is "cool." "he real reason I wrote is to respond to Barb Wire's cartoon on pg. 8. I found this very funny because in May I was in Tosta Rica to visit friends and had my rented car proken into. They got my camera bag which also had my Walkman and about 40 tapes in it. I laugh about it now as I think of some Costa Rican burglar trying to understand my New Order tape! However your "impression" of Jentral American poverty is quite a long way from reality. I lived in Panama and Costa Rica for two years, and got a good, and I believe, accurate view of the people and their way of life. I lived in small towns and large cities, and no matter how poor these people were, they all still seemed to have Boom Boxes and color T.V.'s. They are a proud and clean people. It always struck to as incredible to see people who lived in firt-floored houses step out in the morning looking clean and fresh in nice, new, and washed clothes. Abject squalor is as alien to them as it is to us, and although their standard of living is so such lower than ours that we can barely imagine it, don't paint them as rag-clad and barefoot. That isn't reality for all but the tiniest minority of campesinos (peasants) who live in the remotest villages. I've been in villages consisting of a half-dozen huts built of sticks and mud, and they all had electricity and TV sets. In Costa Rica, in fact, the Black Plag shirts would probably be appreciated, as there is a small "Punk Movement there in San Jose, the capital. I think that Barb Wire's impression is a common one due to the US Towsmedia that continually tries to convince us that we are responsible for the world's problems and especially for Central American poverty, which seems to be "in" with the Media these days. It seems to me that Costa Rica, which is the most prosperous and most free of the Central American republics is the one that has refused Uncle Sam relief when it was tied to concessions to the US way of life. By telling us to "Puck off" and running their country for themselves, the Costa Ricans have forged a government that works for them by adapting elements from other governments, and WOT by giving into Vashington and trying to run a "little TSA" in the jungle. This is precisely why Bl Salvador has so many problems: we won't let them run their own country! They have to solve their problems in their own way or they will only get worse and they'll only hate us Then Washington can learn to keep it's nose out of the affairs of other countries, the whole world will be better off. If we continue to meddle in Salvadoran affairs, we are going to end up with another Micaragua. I have many who were Sandinistas in Wicaragua, who helped overthrow Somoza and put The Sandinistas in power. Most of them are now Contras, who realize how their "Revolution" has betrayed them. Conditions are so such worse now than before, that most people would welcome a return of Somoza as

Well, this is probably a lot more of my political opinions than any of you would like to hear. I just wish that we could get some accurate coverage of world affairs in the media so that people like Barb Wire wouldn't make mistakes like that!

Defence headquarters on bomb list, court told

NEW WESTMINSTER, B.C. (CP) — A terrorist bombing campaign whose targets included defence headquarters in Ottawa was being plotted by Brent Taylor, the last member of the Squamish Five group to be sentenced, Crown Counsel Jim Jardine said in British Columbia Supreme Court On Monday.

Jardine also told Mr. Justice Samuel Toy during a pre-sentence hearing that Taylor, whom he described as one of the ideological leaders of the group, had also purchased a book that the accussed described as "perfect" for assassinations and kidnappings.

Toy reserved sentencing until this morning. Taylor, 77, was found guilty by a B.C. Supreme Court jury last month along with his 30-year-old girl firlend Ann Brit Hansen, of conspiring to rob a Brink's armored car guard; three counts of car theft and possession of \$20,000 worth of stolen mountaineering and theft of firearms from a Richmond, B.C. guncolector.

Taylor subsequently pleaded guilty to unlawful

possession of 680 kilograms of explosives plus weapons.

BROKEN TALENT

BIO-TYPE THING

Broken Talent have been around in one form or another since 1980. In the beginning, it was Malcolm and Santo bashing on accountic guitars and making cassettes under the name of the Friedles, Broken Talent really started percolating in early 1985 when Malcolm went to visit Santo at the University of Florida. Late one night, in a fit of boredom, they created "My God Can Beat Up Your God" and things have been jumping ever since, as they may in the business.

when Santo got sick of U of P,he abscorded home to beautiful Hisland, Pls. where he set back up with Malcolm, and together they formed the Priests with a couple of layabout musicians. (They chose "The Priests" as a name because their first gig was at a Christianity vs Atheise forms (which never came off)). Later they changed their name to Broken Palate, but is a typographical error ontheir first flyer made them Broken Talent (which some eny is more approppriate, but we won't get into that now).

The early line up of Broken Talent was no big deal, but things improved whee the drummer quit in disgust, saying that Broken Talent didn't play "music". Things got even roader when the guitar player ran away to New Mexico and disappeared. This led to the recruitment of Cat on drums and the novement of Malcolm over to guitar. This line up created an art riot at Flynn's Bar on Miami Beach. Later, Marky Awesome was found in South Miami and the classic Aroked Talent line up was born to strike fear in the hearts of people who love punk. With Santo on vocals, Malcolm on bass, Cat on drums, and Marky on guitar, they went into Cat's living room in early 1984 to record "Blood Slut", their first single, on TPOS records.

In spite of a hard core of followers, club owners (both of them) in Mismi have been loathe to book Broken Telent."Too noisy.Unprofessional."They say. With these thoughts in mind, "Blood Slut" at #35 on the Florida alternative charts, and the support of fans in 4 states, Broken Telent set out to compute the world piece by piece, starting in the Southern United States, alongwith Generic Death in mid-1984.

Broken falent used to be nearly pure noise (mostly because of lack of proficiency with instruments) but their sound has evolved into a quirky sourt of "punk rook" (for want of a better term) influenced by the Velvet Underground, Kew York Dolla, Joy Division, Elack Flag, and any number of American hardcore bands. They are very such into the Florida scene and set up their own all ages shows as an alternative to the club-dominated scene. They are also heavily into the doings in other parts of the country and helping out however they can in out of state scenes. Their label, TPOS, is responsible for the newsletter of the same name, and is planning the release of an iF by Generic Death. Broken Talent are now in the studio recording 9 songs for use on an EP, cassette, or compilation album/tape, whichever is sore suitable.

All four members of Broken Talent contribute lyrics, susic and arrangement to the repretoir. Before Broken Talent, Marky was (and possibly still is) guitarist for the Pop Cruds, who are producing a cassette for the public to inspired consume. Pop Cruds are a great (in sy opinion) Ramones/Dollsfoutfit. Malcolm is an unfortunate veteran of several Black Babbath copy bands prior to the advent of Broken Talent. Both Santo and Cat have had all of their experience in Broken Talent or its precursors. Malcolm and Marky have formed Verbal Circus, an out-and-out wild art amalgamation who have so far been banned from playing a club and an art gallery. Their vocalist gets lyrics from the "Weekly World News".

Broken Talent are TFOS, and vice-versa. Together with other South Florida and out of state bands, they are slowly creating something. Exactly what, we don't yet-know. Should be interesting to find out.

The bands are old and there are few hot new bands.

At first it was hard. No one from other scenes would accept us. Ownard only came up to try to scam on our girls. Golden Voice scam on our girls. 



Of course, the oar owners will like it too, they'll begin to realize they an sell more drinks if bands are playing original material (laughter) than if they're playin' cover tunes! Wouldn't that be something.

I would like to see it that way, I really would.

Bands, when they start learning about what originals are going to flop with an audience, then you can go back and trite a good original that people are going to get into, and go back and try again. Sventually you develop into a good band at that year, Right now the 'scene' up here doesn't really allow for it, but it could if the bands started reversing their mentility. So now we're in the lonely few...a couple of other bands in town are trying it, but they haven't come out as much as we have, yet. Hopefully there will be more...we're all waiting! Hopefully we won't all be old and retired by the time that happens. We'd like to see some gut-sy radio programmers out there who are willing to play some good local products (and not just ours) and play them on a regular basis.




